Cathodic Protection Project

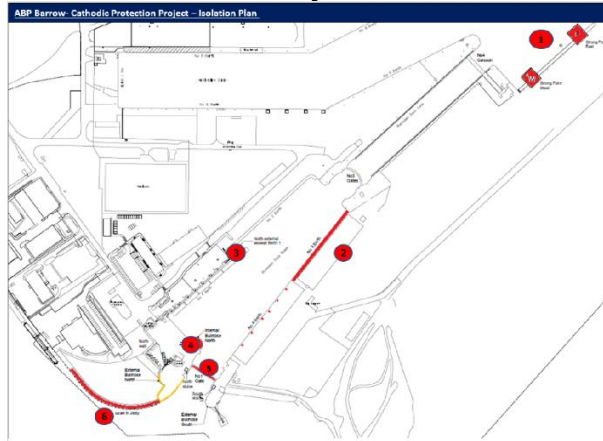
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that diving operations will be conducted within the inner dock system and on the Lead-in Jetty, for a period of approximately 4 months from November 2022 until end of February 2023.

Alpha flag will be displayed when divers are in the water. All mariners are to keep a wide berth and reduce speed when passing the dive barge and support vessel 'Mojo'

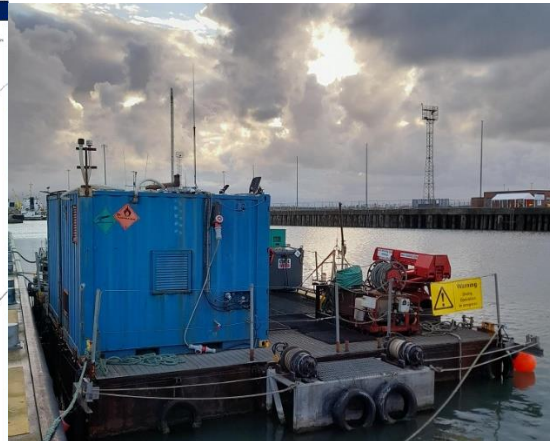
All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout their operations. Mariners may also request information from "Barrow Port Radio" also on VHF Channel 12.
