

NOTICE TO MARINERS No.21 of 2024 Barrow Channels Maintenance Dredge

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **Wednesday 12th June 2024** and until further notice, the trailer suction hopper dredger, <u>SHOALWAY</u> will commence dredging the Barrow approach channels between Sea 1 Buoy and Ramsden Dock Entrance.



Mariners should expect to encounter the vessel at any time and at any position between Ramsden Dock Entrance and the disposal area (which is approximately 2 miles South of Sea 1 Buoy).

The dredger & the survey crafts (Aramis, and Christine H) will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.

Mariners are requested to give these vessels a wide berth when dredging/surveying or dumping spoils in the disposal area. The dredger should be given a wide berth when transiting the Barrow approach channels as she may be constrained by her draught.

All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout their operations. Mariners may also request dredger movement and information from "Barrow Port Radio" also on VHF Channel 12. A further notice will be issued upon completion.
