

## PORT OF BARROW

### NOTICE TO MARINERS No.21 of 2024 Barrow Channels Maintenance Dredge

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2024** and until further notice, the trailer suction hopper dredger, SHOALWAY will commence dredging the Barrow approach channels between Sea 1 Buoy and Ramsden Dock Entrance.



Mariners should expect to encounter the vessel at any time and at any position between Ramsden Dock Entrance and the disposal area (which is approximately 2 miles South of Sea 1 Buoy).

The dredger & the survey crafts (**Aramis**, and **Christine H**) will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.

Mariners are requested to give these vessels a wide berth when dredging/surveying or dumping spoils in the disposal area. The dredger should be given a wide berth when transiting the Barrow approach channels as she may be constrained by her draught.

All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout their operations. Mariners may also request dredger movement and information from "Barrow Port Radio" also on VHF Channel 12. A further notice will be issued upon completion.
