## NOTICE TO MARINERS Lowestoft Approaches – East Cardinal/Twin Buoy off Station

Mariners and Port Users are advised that the East Cardinal Twin (or Sewer) Buoy, normal position 52° 28.89'N, 001° 46.24'E, is currently off station. The buoy previously drifted away from its charted position but has now been located and recovered.

The South Cardinal Twin Buoy remains on station in position: 52°28.84'N, 001° 46.25'.

Mariners are requested to consider the temporary absence of the East cardinal Twin buoy when passage planning/navigating in Lowestoft Approaches..

A notice will be issued when the East cardinal Twin Buoy has been re-instated in its charted position.
