NOTICE TO MARINERS Lowestoft Outer Harbour and Approaches – Dredging and Survey Activity – Update No.1

Mariners and Port Users are advised that continued dredging and survey activities arescheduled for Lowestoft Approaches and Outer Harbour Area as follows: -

Grab dredger UKD Cherry Sand, already working in the Harbour, will undertake dredging on 30th and 31st May.

Working Hours: normally 0700hrs-1900hrs daily, but may work split shifts (mornings and evenings), to suit tide times.

Suction Dredger Sospan Dau, will complete work on 1st June, then will depart Lowestoft. Sospan Dau will be replaced by trailing suction dredger 'Scald', which is scheduled to commence work on 7th June.

Working Hours: 24hrs until late July

Plough dredger MTS Valour commences work on 29th May until late July.

Working Hours: normally 0700hrs-1900hrs daily.

Dredging Operations will be supported by small survey craft 'Sea Eagle' or substitute craft. Surveys will be conducted on an ad-hoc basis subject to dredging activity. Surveys will be conducted during daylight hours only.

Timings are subject to weather and operational delays, so may change slightly.

Dredgers will display lights and shapes for dredging activities as prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea. They will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch 14. Vessel movements will be co-ordinated via Lowestoft Port Control.

Mariners are requested to afford dredging and survey activities a wide berth if practical and safe to do so, and to pass at slow speed.

This notice supersedes NTM 19/2024, which is hereby cancelled.
