The port industry in the UK is the second largest in Europe and Associated British Ports (ABP) is the largest port operator in the country, with 21 ports around Britain.

ABP's ports include Immingham, the UK's largest port by tonnage, and Southampton, the nation's second largest container port, as well as the UK's number one port for cars and cruise. Every year, ABP handles around 25% of all UK seaborne trade - more than 85 million tonnes of cargo.

Collectively the ports handle around 1.4 million containers, 1.7 million vehicles and around 3 million cruise and ferry passengers each year. We also own and run Britain's busiest inland rail terminal, Hams

We're committed to innovation, which is why we've invested over £100 million in new technology and state of-the-art facilities since July 2016. We're taking the lead in safeguarding the future of the British Maritime industry by supporting the government's Maritime 2050 initiative and working closely with government and supply chain representatives to help Britain continue to compete on a global scale.

In fact, our current investment programme promises to further increase our contribution to regional economies around the UK. There's no better time to join our business and grow your career with us.

Doing our bit

As the UK's leading port operator, we have a responsibility to make a difference. We're working hard to improve gender parity in our industry by supporting initiatives such as Women in Manufacturing and the Women in Maritime Taskforce.

In July 2019, ABP became the first UK port operator to provide personal protective equipment (PPE) designed especially for women. The move represented a great step in ABP's efforts to further the role of women in maritime, whilst further improving safety standards and choice for its workforce.

In January 2021, ABP's ports in Southampton and East Anglia were recognised by Maritime UK's Diversity in Maritime Charter for their success in implementing initiatives to attract a more diverse workforce.

We're also committed to reducing our carbon footprint – we've invested in electric vehicles, alternatives to plastic, and we're on track to become one of the UK's largest corporate producers of renewable energy.



Our ports contribute £7.5 billion to the UK economy

Successful candidates will be given wider development opportunities, such as project management, health and safety, leadership core skills throughout the duration of the scheme, all with the support of a senior mentor.

The schemes will be very challenging, offering a unique opportunity to develop a range of key skills that will be essential to a successful career with ABP.


